- **3. We'll contact you!** Once we receive your completed questionnaire, we will schedule a time for you to meet with one of our Pastors. This allows us to get to know you and to discuss further the commitment and journey of leadership.

## **Christian Assembly Leader Commitments**

As a leader at Christian Assembly we ask that you commit to the following:

#### **Expectations of a Group Leader:**

- 1. Discipleship: A leader is a believer in the gospel of Jesus Christ, has a personal and growing relationship with Jesus and is baptized as an outward expression of that relationship. (Matthew 22:37-29, Colossians 2:12-15)
- 2. **Scripture**: A leader recognizes the Bible as the authority for their life and actively seeks to develop and deepen their knowledge of God's Word. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)
- 3. Prayer: A leader is committed to praying for those they lead and for Christian Assembly. (1 Timothy 2:1)
- 4. **Generosity**: A leader practices a consistent pattern of financial giving to the purposes of God in the local church and in the work of his Kingdom. (Matthew 6:19-21)
- 5. **Faithful**: A leader follows through on commitments made to their group and to the church staff. (Psalm 89:34)
- 6. Sobriety: A leader pursues sobriety from addictive substances and behaviors. (1 Corinthians 6:12)
- 7. Holiness: A leader observes the Biblical boundaries of sexual purity (i.e. a heterosexual marriage, no sex outside of marriage, commitment to pursing holiness). (1 Thessalonians 4:3-7; 1 Corinthians 6:18-20)

#### Requirements of a Group Leader:

- 1. Make Christian Assembly your home church and attend the Starting Point Class (if you have not already done so) in order to better understand who we are as a church. Note: we do have leaders who attend other churches we just need to discuss this arrangement.
- 2. Meet with one of the Women's Ministry Pastors periodically throughout the year for equipping, care and prayer as you lead your group.
- 3. Attend all leader gatherings and required trainings.
- 4. Commit to the mission of Christian Assembly:
  - "God's grace compels us to lead spiritually convinced and unconvinced people to complete commitment in Jesus Christ."
