1)	Be a believer in the gospel of Jesus Christ, have a personal, growing relationship with Him and get baptized as a symbol of that relationship if you have not already done so. [Matthew 22:37-38, Colossians 2:12-15]
2)	Recognize the Bible as the authority for your life and seek ways to develop and deepen your knowledge of God's word. [2 Timothy 3:16-17]
3)	Be committed to praying for those you lead and for Christian Assembly. [1 Timothy 2:1]
4)	Practice a consistent pattern of financial giving to the purpose of God in the local church and in the
	outward work of God's Kingdom. [Matthew 6:19-21]
5)	Follow through on commitments that you make to your group and to the church staff. [Psalm 89:34]
6)	Pursue sobriety from addictive substances and behaviors. [1 Corinthians 6:12]
7)	Observe the Biblical boundaries of sexual purity. Christian marriage is between a man and a woman sex is an expression of that covenant, not to be practiced outside of marriage. [1 Thessalonians 4:1-3]

1)	Make Christian Assembly your home church.
2)	Attend the Starting Point class at Christian Assembly.
