### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: HONEY NUT CHEERIOS



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

This cereal makes you think of the busy bee all hyped up on lots of honey. Kids will learn that Jesus wants us to spend time with him, and not just rush around like busy bees. Luke 10:38-42, Mary and Martha



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Help your kids find and set up a place in their rooms for a daily quiet time with Jesus. Encourage them to make it a daily habit, and make a point to praise their efforts when you see them do so.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why was Martha upset that Mary was not helping her?
- What did Jesus say to Martha?
- Why is it important to set aside time for Jesus?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:
