As a member of the CA Staff, I commit to respond to God's grace through:

Worship: I will be a whole-hearted worshipper.

- * Prayer: I commit to pray regularly to grow my ability to hear from & obey the Lord. I will pray for the church & our ministries in an ongoing basis. (Eph. 6:18)
- * Scripture: I commit to read and interact with the Bible on a regular basis to grow my relationship with God. (Rom. 12:1-2; Heb. 4:11-16)
- * Purity: While no one is without sin, I will seek to be a person of purity as God commands. (Matt. 5:8; Phil. 1:10; 1 Pet. 2:11)
- * Generosity: I will be faithful and generous in the finances I give to the general offerings as well as the kingdom offerings of CA. (Mk. 6:21)
- * Humility: I will follow Christ's example of humility. (Jn. 13:12-17)
