Frequently Asked Questions:

Can I register my child on the first day of camp?

In order to best serve you and your child, registration must be completed no later than the Wednesday prior to the start of your week of Neighborhood Day Camp.

Do we have to be members of the Host Church to attend?

You do not need to be members of the Host Church in order to attend Neighborhood Day Camp. The camp experience is open to all children who have completed Kinder through 5th grades, depending on availability.

What should my child bring every day?

- Please pack a bag with:
- Sack Lunch
- Sunscreen
- Water Bottle
- Bible
- Pen/Pencil
- Towel
- Bathing Suit
- Change of Clothes (just in case)
- Shoes that can get wet (sandals with heel strap are okay; no flip flops please)
- Do not bring toys, cell phones, MP3 players, or any other valuable items.

What should my child wear?

• Your child will be making a tie dye shirt during this week. Their hands will get dye on them and it will wash off. While we do our best to keep the dye from getting on clothes and shoes, drips my occur. Send them in clothes that can get messy.

- Weather-appropriate clothing that can get dirty and may get wet. This is camp, after all!
- Shoes or sandals with a heel strap so that your child can run and play safely.
- We have theme days for your child to earn spirit points for his or her team:

o Wednesday – Wacky Wednesday! IDEAS: BRIGHT colors, crazy hair, silly hats, tacky clothes, backwards/inside out clothing

o Friday – Wear camp tie dye t-shirt

What does a typical day look like?

Will you provide medical care on site?

At a minimum, we will have a trained medic who is certified in CPR & First Aid.

What time is drop-off and pick-up?

• **Drop-off on Monday** takes a bit more time than the rest of the week. We will open at 8:45 am for you to check in your child, complete forms and make final payment (cash or check to the church). You will also have the opportunity to meet your child's counselor and program dean.

• **Drop-off Tuesday-Friday** is 8:45am until 9:00am. You can drop off your child at the curb or walk them into their team locations.

• Pick-up is 4:00pm every day except Friday. The person picking up your child will need to come into the church, show his/her picture ID, and sign out your child every day. Only adults who are listed in your check-in sheet Monday will be able to take your child out of our care.

• Friday at 4:00pm we have our closing celebration! This is an opportunity for you to witness more of your child's week through a large group time and hear directly from your counselor and child about their experience. This celebration will be over by 5:00pm when you will check out your child from their small group celebration.
