Below are some study questions that will help you and your Life Group dig deeper into this weekend's sermon. We've included plenty of questions, but feel free to use just a few or to choose whichever questions best fit your group.

Bible Questions:

- 1. Read Matthew 28:16-20.
 - a. Ask group members to read the passage again on their own. Give them 5
 minutes to sit in the passage and make note of anything that stands out to them.
 What do you notice in this passage? What can we learn from this passage?
 What does this passage teach us about God? Then share your thoughts as a group.

Application Questions:

- 1. Matt shared a story of a missionary to Papua New Guinea that was frustrated when his approach to sharing the gospel did not work out at first. Have you ever experienced frustration when sharing your faith has not yielded the desired results?
 - a. How have you overcome these frustrations?
- 2. What is one unreached people group that God has placed a burden in your heart for?
 - a. How might God be inviting you to become part of that mission?
- 3. Matt talked about 4 actions that we can take to begin answering the global question (Pray, Learn, Give, Go);
 - a. Which of these do you find easiest to move in and why?
 - b. Which one is most challenging and why?
 - c. Which of these 4 actions could you consider taking in the coming weeks?
- 4. What are some ways that we can be encouraging those around us that are "sent"?

Closing & Prayer: [set aside 10-20 minutes for prayer]

Pray for the things shared in your group. Pray that the Holy Spirit would be empowering group members to be thinking about answering the global question and their responsibility to the unreached. Spend time praying for global unreached people groups and the missionary efforts in those areas.
