Below are some study questions that will help you and your Life Group dig deeper into this weekend's sermon. We've included plenty of questions, but feel free to use just a few or to choose whichever questions best fit your group.

### Bible Questions:

1. Read Exodus 3:15 & Psalm 100:5
  - a. Ask group members to read the verses again on their own. Give them a few minutes and then ask the following question: What can we learn about God in these verses?

### Application Questions:

2. Tom opened his sermon by stating: What we believe about the gospel's power with the next generation depends in part on who we trust - sociologists or the Bible.
  - a. How did hearing the stories of people coming to Christ (ie, "Got Faith" school club, response to "Woodlawn" movie, 2.4 million more Christ followers today than 2007) impact your belief?
3. Tom shared one study on Millennials (15-35 yr olds) which summed up their view of the world as "moralistic, therapeutic deism", which essentially means "do good, be happy – God is real, but probably not very involved in daily life."
  - a. Has this view of God ever been your own? Why or why not?
  - b. Why do you think millennials might take this view?
4. Tom said that God is a "multi-generational God," therefore, we are to be a "multi-generational church always seeking to share the good news in tangible ways with the next generation."
  - a. What might it look like for you to share the good news in tangible ways with the next generation?
  - b. Are there currently any "next generation" people in your life that you are impacting or leading? If yes, what are some of the tangible ways you are sharing with them the good news?

### Closing & Prayer: *[set aside 10-20 minutes for prayer]*

Break into partners and pray for each other:

- Pray for God to bring into your life multi-generational opportunities to share your faith and invite others to do life with you.
- If your view of God is that He's not very involved in your daily life, pray that God would reveal Himself to you as the God who is active and close by.
- Pray for any other personal needs that you may have.
