Below are some study questions that will help you and your Life Group dig deeper into this weekend's sermon. We've included plenty of questions, but feel free to use just a few or to choose whichever questions best fit your group.

Bible Questions:

1. Read John 1:35-39.
 - a. Ask group members to read the passage again on their own. Give them a few minutes to sit with the passage and then ask the following questions:
 - i. How would YOU answer today Jesus' question to John's disciples, "What are you looking for?" (ie, security, purpose, love, joy, significance, belonging, etc) Share about why you answered that way.
 - ii. Why do you think Jesus answered, "Come and see"?
 - iii. What do you think they may have witnessed or heard in remaining with Him the rest of the day? How might this have impacted them?

Application Questions:

2. Tom shared the thought that "When we are curious enough to ask, Jesus invites us to care enough to act."
 - a. Where do you think God has been nudging or prompting you to "care enough to act"?
 - b. Is anything standing in the way of you responding?
3. John's disciples responded to Jesus' "Come and see" and spent the "rest of the day" with Him.
 - a. What are some ways that God is inviting you to "come and see" Him?
 - b. How do you think responding might impact your life?
4. What is one way you are excited to grow personally through the Curious series and/or reading Curious?

Closing & Prayer: *[set aside 10-20 minutes for prayer]*

Break into partners and pray for each other:

- Earlier you answered the question, "What are you looking for?" Pray that God would help you find what you are looking for. Also, pray for God's help if you sense He is asking you to "care enough to act" but you've been fearful or hesitant to do so.
- Pray for any other personal needs that you may have.
