

GETTING STARTED

We're so glad you're joining us this summer to read through the book of Psalms in the Bible! We encourage you to set aside time to read the Psalms at the start of your day. Try to find a quiet space. Begin by praying and asking God to speak to you through His Word. We encourage you to read the Psalms slowly. Consider reading them out loud or multiple times.

AS YOU READ

Here are some different options for you to try as you engage with the Psalms each day.



Reflect on these questions

- 1. What does this Psalm say about God?
- 2. What truth from this Psalm do I need to cling to today?
- 3. How will I live differently today because of reading this Psalm?



Journal

Grab a journal and respond to what you've read by writing down your thoughts, feelings and questions about the Psalms. Consider writing down a key verse that stood out to you.



Memorize Scripture

Pick a verse(s) that you want to memorize from the Psalm. Write it down and commit it to memory as a way of keeping God's Word with you.



Pray the Psalms

Use the Psalms you're reading as a way of praying for yourself, our church and the world. Take different verses and pray them aloud to God.



Use the SOAP Method

Scripture: Read the Psalm once or twice.

Observation: Observe people, places, actions, repeating words or

phrases, questions or anything else that stands out to

you and write them down.

Application: What is God saying to you through this Psalm and

your observations? How might you live differently as a

result of your reading?

Prayer: Ask God to help you remember and apply His Word

to your life.
