**Hebrews 11:1** – Faith is the confidence that what we hope for will actually happen; it gives us assurance about things we cannot see

**Romans 3:30** - There is only one God, and he makes people right with himself only by faith

James 2:19-23 - <sup>19</sup>You say you have faith, for you believe that there is one God. Good for you! Even the demons believe this, and they tremble in terror. <sup>20</sup>How foolish! Can't you see that faith without good deeds is useless? <sup>21</sup> Don't you remember that our ancestor Abraham was shown to be right with God by his actions when he offered his son Isaac on the altar? <sup>22</sup>You see, his faith and his actions worked together. His actions made his faith complete. <sup>23</sup>And so it happened just as the Scriptures say: "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." He was even called the friend of God.

**Romans 1:17** – For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."

**Habakkuk 2:4** - "Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked. But the righteous will live by their faithfulness to God.

Hebrews 11:8-13, 33-40 - ...<sup>8</sup>It was by faith that Abraham obeyed when God called him to leave home and go to another land that God would give him as his inheritance. He went without knowing where he was going. <sup>9</sup>And even when he reached the land God promised him, he lived there by faith—for he was like a foreigner, living in tents. And so did Isaac and Jacob, who inherited the same promise. <sup>10</sup>Abraham was confidently looking

forward to a city with eternal foundations. a city designed and built by God. 11It was by faith that even Sarah was able to have a child, though she was barren and was too old. She believed that God would keep his promise. <sup>12</sup>And so a whole nation came from this one man who was as good as dead—a nation with so many people that, like the stars in the sky and the sand on the seashore, there is no way to count them. <sup>13</sup>All these people died still believing what God had promised them. They did not receive what was promised, but they saw it all from a distance and welcomed it. They gareed that they were foreigners and nomads here on earth... <sup>33</sup>By faith these people overthrew kingdoms, ruled with justice, and received what God had promised them. They shut the mouths of lions, <sup>34</sup>quenched the flames of fire, and escaped death by the edge of the sword. Their weakness was turned to strenath. They became strong in battle and put whole armies to flight. 35Women received their loved ones back again from death. But others were tortured, refusing to turn from God in order to be set free. They placed their hope in a better life after the resurrection. <sup>36</sup>Some were jeered at, and their backs were cut open with whips. Others were chained in prisons. <sup>37</sup>Some died by stoning, some were sawed in half, and others were killed with the sword. Some went about wearing skins of sheep and goats, destitute and oppressed and mistreated. 38They were too good for this world, wandering over deserts and mountains, hiding in caves and holes in the ground. <sup>39</sup>All these people earned a good reputation because of their faith, yet none of them received all that God had promised. <sup>40</sup>For God had something better in mind for us, so that they would not reach perfection without us.
