Genesis 9:12 - Then God said, "I am giving you a sign of my covenant with you and with all living creatures, for all generations to come. I have placed my rainbow in the clouds. It is the sign of my covenant with you and with all the earth."

Exodus 3:5-6 - "Do not come any closer," the LORD warned. "Take off your sandals, for you are standing on holy ground. I am the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." (In other words, a multigenerational God) When Moses heard this, he covered his face because he was afraid to look at God.

Exodus 3:15 - God also said to Moses, "Say this to the people of Israel: Yahweh, the God of your ancestors—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob—has sent me to you. This is my eternal name, my name to remember for all generations."

Psalm 100:5 - For the LORD is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and his faithfulness continues to each generation.

Psalm 78:5-7 - God commanded our ancestors to teach his instructions to their children, so the next generation might know them -even the children not yet born - and they in turn will teach their own children. So each generation should set its hope anew on God, not forgetting his glorious miracles and obeying his commands.

Isaiah 51:8 - My salvation will continue from generation to generation.

Acts 17:27 - God's purpose was for the nations to seek after God and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him—though he is not far from any one of us.

Matthew 24:34-40 - Then the King will say to those on his right, "Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the creation of the world. For I was hungry, and you fed me. I was thirsty, and you gave me a drink. I was a stranger, and you invited me into your home. I was naked, and you gave me clothing. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me." Then these righteous ones will reply, "Lord, when did we ever see you hungry and feed you? Or thirsty and give you something to drink? Or a stranger and show you hospitality? Or naked and give you clothing? When did we ever see you sick or in prison and visit you?" And the King will say, "I tell you the truth, when you did it to one of the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were doing it to me!"
