Galatians 6:7-8 (NIV) - ⁷Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A person reaps what he sows. 8Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.
