Real ID: Who God Says You Are Matt Price

Matthew 4:18-22 (NLT) - ¹⁸One day as Jesus was walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers-Simon, also called Peter, and Andrew-throwing a net into the water, for they fished for a living.¹⁹Jesus called out to them, "Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" ²⁰And they left their nets at once and followed him. ²¹A little farther up the shore he saw two other brothers, James and John, sitting in a boat with their father, Zebedee, repairing their nets. And he called them to come, too. ²²They immediately followed him, leaving the boat and their father behind.

Matthew 8:18-22 (NLT) - ¹⁸When Jesus saw the crowd around him, he instructed his disciples to cross to the other side of the lake.¹⁹Then one of the teachers of religious law said to him, "Teacher, I will follow you wherever you go." ²⁰But Jesus replied, "Foxes have dens to live in, and birds have nests, but the Son of Man has no place even to lay his head." ²¹Another of his disciples said, "Lord, first let me return home and bury my father." ²²But Jesus told him, "Follow me now. Let the spiritually dead bury their own dead."

Matthew 9:9 (NLT) - As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at his tax collector's booth. "Follow me and be my disciple," Jesus said to him. So Matthew got up and followed him.

Matthew 10:1-4 (NLT) - ¹Jesus called his twelve disciples together and gave them authority to cast out evil spirits and to heal every kind of disease and illness. ²Here are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon (also called Peter), then Andrew (Peter's brother), James (son of Zebedee), John (James's brother), ³Philip, Bartholomew, Thomas, Matthew (the tax collector), James (son of Alphaeus), Thaddaeus, ⁴Simon (the zealot), Judas Iscariot (who later betrayed him).

Matthew 16:24-26 (NLT) - ²⁴Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross, and follow me. ²⁵If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake, you will save it. ²⁶And what do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul? Is anything worth more than your soul?

Matthew 28:16-20 (NLT) - ¹⁶Then the eleven disciples left for Galilee, going to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. ¹⁷When they saw him, they

worshiped him—but some of them doubted! ¹⁸Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth.¹⁹Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."
