Mark 10:17-22 (NRSV) - <sup>17</sup>As he was setting out on a journey, a man ran up and knelt before him. and asked him, 'Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?' <sup>18</sup>Jesus said to him. 'Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. <sup>19</sup>You know the commandments: "You shall not murder: You shall not commit adultery: You shall not steal; You shall not bear false witness; You shall not defraud: Honour vour father and mother."<sup>20</sup>He said to him, 'Teacher, I have kept all these since my youth.' <sup>21</sup>Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said, 'You lack one thing; go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me.' <sup>22</sup>When he heard this, he was shocked and went away grieving, for he had many possessions.

Ephesians 4:18 (NRSV) - They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of their ignorance and hardness of heart.

Hebrews 3:12-15 (NRSV) - <sup>12</sup>Take care, brothers and sisters, that none of you may have an evil. unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. <sup>13</sup>But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called 'today', so that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.<sup>14</sup>For we have become partners of Christ, if only we hold our first confidence firm to the end. <sup>15</sup>As it is said, 'Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.'

Romans 12:2 (NRSV) - Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect.

# **MESSAGE NOTES**

Acts 4:36-37 (NRSV) - <sup>36</sup>There was a Levite, a native of Cyprus, Joseph, to whom the apostles gave the name Barnabas (which means 'son of encouragement'). <sup>37</sup>He sold a field that belonged to him, then brought the money, and laid it at the apostles' feet.

Acts 11:24 (NRSV) - for he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were brought to the Lord.

Matthew 22:37-40 (NIV) - 37 Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' <sup>38</sup>This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup>And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' <sup>40</sup>All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

Luke 6:27-28 (NIV) - 27"But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, <sup>28</sup>bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.

Mark 8:34-38 (NLT) - <sup>34</sup>Then, calling the crowd to join his disciples, he said, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross, and follow me. <sup>35</sup>If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake and for the sake of the Good News, you will save it. <sup>36</sup>And what do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul? <sup>37</sup>Is anything worth more than your soul? <sup>38</sup>If anyone is ashamed of me and my message in these adulterous and sinful days, the Son of Man will be ashamed of that person when he returns in the glory of his Father with the holy angels."

Mark 9:1-3 (NLT) - <sup>1</sup>Jesus went on to say, "I tell you the truth, some standing here right now will not die before they see the Kingdom of God arrive in great power!" <sup>2</sup>Six days later Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed, <sup>3</sup> and his clothes became dazzling white, far whiter than any earthly bleach could ever make them.
